We had a great time with Carol Spohn again in July. She always has a bunch of creative tips to use in painting, she makes things look easy and is a lot of fun.

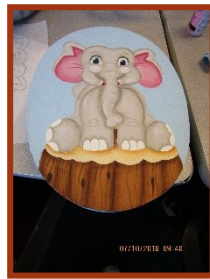

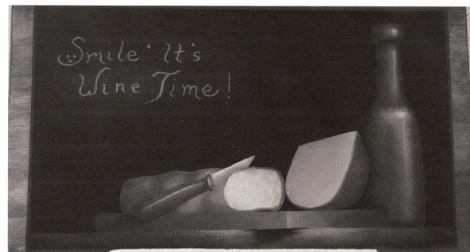

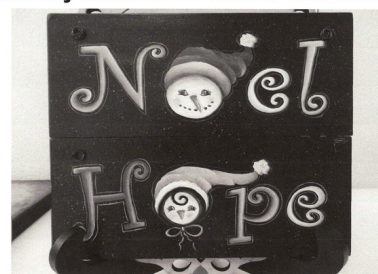

Good Liner, 1 or 2 good rounds & Floater

Grey and White graphite, small sharp scissors, ½" to 1" wide offset spatula palette knife for spreading crackle paste. 2 sheets of blue shop towels cut into quarters, black and white columnar newsprint text (or dictionary sheet or encyclopedia text), old scruffy brush for applying matte medium, blow dryer (optional) and regular acrylic painting supplies. Selection of brushes that include 18/0 or 10/0 short liner and 1" flat or angle for floating the edge of canvas.

Misc. Supplies

Palette paper, tracing paper, water container, paper towels, pencil, eraser, stylus, brush cleaner, scotch magic tape.
Small containers to take home extra paint.

Gateway Decorative Artists Chapter Meeting Minutes
June 10, 2018

The chapter meeting was held at Checkered Cottage, Kirkwood, MO. Board members present included Gloria Falk, Milly Johnson, Jean Lindsey, and Donna Wessel. Also present, Acting Program Chair, Barb Ogden. Board member, Marilyn Hartnett, was absent.

The meeting was called to order at 1:00 p.m. by President, Gloria Falk. Members and guests were welcomed. Linda Nelson gave the invocation followed by Grace for the refreshments to follow the meeting.

With no corrections, the April meeting minutes were approved as printed in the newsletter. With no questions or corrections, the May Treasurer's Report will be filed as published in the newsletter.

The National Museum of Decorative Painting in Atlanta, GA. is now closed. Some pieces in the collection will be donated to other museums. The bulk of the pieces, all 1400 of them, will be housed at the SDP Museum in Wichita, KS. SDP staff will be traveling to Atlanta to pack up and transport the artwork.

Gloria talked about the SDP Chapter Achievement Award and the requirements needed to receive it. During 2017 Gateway achieved 16 of 18 items to qualify.

Milly presented the information on the Hannibal Retreat, Sept 21 to 23. There will be four, four-hour classes. Retreat sign in will begin at 2 p.m. on Friday afternoon followed by the MITI's prior to Friday evening dinner.

Fri. evening class is Ellen Rohne – *Smile, It's Wine Time*

Sat. morning will be Barb Ogden--*Ollie Owl*

Sat. afternoon will be Mary Jo Kumer--*Noel and Hope*

Sat. evening will be the River Cruise Dinner; cost \$40. Those not participating will be on their own for dinner.

Sun. morning will be Donna Wessel—*Mixed Media Orchids*

Close out the weekend with a Brunch.

MITI submission was extended to the September meeting. Currently there is only one scheduled. Milly would like two more to fill Friday afternoon. Checks and Registration forms can be mailed to the address on the form or to Milly's Abby Rose Gallery, 110 North Main Street, Hannibal, MO 63401. Registration fee is \$50. The River Cruise Dinner is optional at a cost of \$40. Everyone is responsible for making their own hotel reservations. Hannibal Tourism has a map of hotels and locations. FYI: Hannibal will be tearing down the old lighthouse to build a new one, so this will be your last chance to visit the old one.

Barb Ogden reported that Sandy Aubuchon is still in the hospital. She had a heart monitor put in and has been on a feeding tube the past two weeks. The rescheduled class is Aug 17, at 9 a.m. at Lindell bank. Be sure you have your piece prepped because there is a lot of work to do ahead of time. The box design was in the Fall 2017 SDP Magazine.

Carol Spohn will be teaching July 19 and 20. The Chickadee will be taught on Thursday and the Flowers on Fri. You will need to bring basic watercolor supplies. Cost is \$65 per day. Class will start at 9 a.m. and finish by 4 p.m.

Ellen Rhone is teaching a cover for the Gateway directory for the paint-in project today. The cost is \$5.

Ellen is leaving on vacation tomorrow. She offered to take some of Donna and Gloria's painted rocks on her trip. Her plan was to leave one in each state she traveled through. Gloria forgot to bring her rocks, but Donna gave Ellen a bag of eleven. Ellen unwrapped them for display during the meeting.

Show & Tell

Peggy Araki brought portraits she had painted in oils. Milly has been experimenting with alcohol inks. She did some on black scrapbooking paper and used compressed air to blow the ink around. After inking she sealed the piece and then added some Mudd.

The program after the September meeting, will be Spencer Meagher doing a watercolor demo.

Mary Jo asked Donna Wright to show her July Memory Box paint-in design. As of the meeting, 186 Memory Boxes have been completed and mailed out. The Memory Box paint-in schedule through year-end will be:
