- -The meeting was turned over to the By-Law committee. Deb Finklang was the moderator, Donna Wessel took notes and Barb Ogden was the timekeeper. All revisions were discussed; some motions were made to change specific Articles; motions and seconds were then made on each individual revision; and each motion passed be a majority vote of the members present. The new Standing Rules and By-Law documents will be published in the first newsletter of 2024. They will also be on the website and in the 2024 Chapter Directory/Calendar sent to members either electronically or printed for pickup at the first 2024 meeting.

Election Chair Cheryll Wilburn discussed the following:

- -Opened the floor for nominations for President, Newsletter Editor and Program Chair.
- -The nominations were Gloria Falk, President, Debbie Finklang, Newsletter Editor and no one ran for Program Chair. A motion was made by Mary Jo Kumer to accept the slate by acclamation and seconded by Debbie Finklang. The motion passed.
