# Urgent appeal from Artistry Today-Miho Halsey

I'm now preparing for the summer issue of *ARTistry Today*. We have wonderful projects again for the next issue, I cannot wait to showcase those for our subscribers. However, today I must share something with all of you painting enthusiasts. And, it's not good news.... disappointing and emotional information instead.

With your support, the situation could change. I need your help! We must have more subscribers to keep our *ARTistry Today* magazine going. Your subscription is the most important thing to us. Every single subscription plays a vital role. As of today, we have less than 100 subscribers in 2025, this is both shocking and heartbreaking to our team, and we hope that it is to you as well. The fact is that this low number of subscribers is not proportionate to the amount of effort we put into featuring the quality projects by incredibly talented artists.

We have continued to listen to our subscribers' opinions and have always been open to any suggestions over the last two years. Starting with the current Spring 2025 issue, changes were implemented based on your feedback. We made the subscription process easier and more convenient without requiring an account log-in; as soon as you subscribe, we automatically email you a one-sheet with links to the electronic flipbook, the entire pdf of the magazine - which is downloadable to print, each project with individual links for both the e-packet for that project and for the individual line art. We also adjusted the payment options to make it easier for you to have an ongoing subscription that you pay for in installments each time a new issue publishes. All of these changes were made in response to "pain points" expressed by our subscribers. Yet, the lack of response to these changes cut our subscriber numbers to not even 25% of where we were in 2024.

The reality is that despite the incredible artists and staff dedicated to sharing high quality projects, we cannot continue without the willingness of each of you as painters to subscribe. I believe our magazine is valuable to decorative painters. I am confident that *ARTistry Today* is the most beautiful and high-quality decorative painting magazine you will find. Each issue features about eight works by various artists in different mediums and at different levels. Not all of them will be to your taste, but this is a useful magazine for continuing the education and legacy of decorative painting, all while featuring a wide array of mediums, styles and skill levels.


So, if you've been waiting to subscribe (renew) for any reason, don't wait any longer. If you don't act now, it sends us the message that you do NOT want *ARTistry Today* to continue. It's important to me and our team that we are transparent and not surprise you with final decisions later. Please be aware that if we do not significantly increase our number of subscribers in the month of May and early June, this Summer issue will be the LAST issue of *ARTistry Today*.
